Summer Camp Director Positions

The Columbia Association has positions available in summer day and trip camps, Mon – Fri, 8:15 a.m. – 3:45 p.m. starting June, 2010. Seeking adults and college graduates with 2 years documented leadership experience and commitment with day camps, or other youth recreation programs. Applicant must be at least 21 years old, able to work outside in summer temperatures. Duties include working with school age campers, planning and implementing camp activities, supervising programs, and other duties required. Compensation \$12.87 and up depending on experience and position.

Camp Division Supervisor Positions

The Columbia Association has positions available in several summer day camps for Division Supervisors, Mon-Fri 8:00AM-4:00PM. Applicants must be at least 21 years old with 2 years documented leadership experience. Duties include supervising staff, planning programs, safety of campers, and other duties as required. Compensation \$12.36 and up depending on experience. Must be able to work for eight weeks

Summer Camp Key Positions

Columbia Association Nature Camp has positions for a Waterfront Specialist, Mon – Fri, 8:15 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Applicant must be at least 18 years old and hold a current Canoe Instructor Certification, Lifeguard, CPR and First Aid Certification. Duties include supervise all lake front activities, serve as primary canoe instructor, and assists the camp director in developing age appropriate lessons for campers. Camps begin June 2010. Compensation starts at \$9.22 and up depending upon experience. Must be able to work for eight weeks.

Summer Camp Lifeguards

Columbia Association has camp positions for certified lifeguards.
